

Q1 Having seen how we believe we should focus our spending in 2020/21, do you agree with our budget plans?





Q2 Which is the most important to you? (Rank from 1-8, with 1 being the most important, and 8 the least)





Q3 Do you agree that we should increase Council tax by £5 per year for a Band D property to help fund these plans?




