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## **Background Information**

- 1. A copy of the Grant Thornton letter relating to the outcome from work carried out to certify the housing benefit subsidy claim for 2014/15 is attached at **Appendix 'A'**.
- 2. Testing from an initial sample of twenty rent allowance cases identified one error where earnings data had been incorrectly entered (leading to an underpayment of benefit) and a second case where evidence of earnings was not available (although there was documentary evidence of a meeting between the claimant and an officer). As a result of these findings, an additional forty earner-related cases were checked. Further errors were identified in six cases.
- 3. A further issue was identified with regard to updating a system parameter on polygamous marriages. Although the Council does not have any relevant cases, it was not possible to provide evidence of this fact to Grant Thornton. Grant Thornton has agreed to work with this Council so that this evidence can be provided in 2015/16.
- 4. Following the audit, the subsidy return (£20.3m) was not adjusted. However, it was qualified.
- 5. The Council is now awaiting a response from the Department for Works and Pensions with regard to finalising the subsidy claim for the financial year 2014/15.

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
