

Local Council Tax Support Scheme - Summary of Public Consultation Responses

The following table summarises the responses from the public consultation. There were a total of 20 responses to the public consultation; 0 of those was in response to postal surveys issued and 20 were on-line responses via the link on the website. The consultation ran for a period of 12 weeks (from 15 August 2016 to 28 October 2016). Of the total 20 respondents 2 indicated that they were currently in receipt of Council Tax Support (0 receiving full, 100% Council Tax Support and 2 receiving partial Council Tax Support) and 17 indicated that they were not in receipt of any Council Tax Support. (one did not indicate anything).
