(iii) Recording of Proceedings

The public proceedings of Council, Cabinet and Committee Meetings may be recorded, which includes filming, as well as audio recording. Photography is also permitted.

Recording/filming should not be disruptive or distracting to the good order and conduct of the Meeting. To assist with this, an area of the Meeting venue will be designated from which proceedings can be recorded/filmed, and 'roaming' around the venue while recording is not permitted. The Chairman will exclude anyone whose behaviour is disruptive.

Recording/filming should only be of Members and Council Officers, and not any members of the public (unless they are formally addressing the Meeting or unless specific permission has been given by those individuals).

The following question has been submitted by Councillor AR Brassington to Councillor Chris Hancock, the Cabinet Member for Enterprise and Partnerships:-

"Cotswold DC has just 2 Electric Vehicle Charging Points (EVCPs) in its car parks and, since their installation, there has been a massive increase in their use. I am aware that CDC is considering increasing the number but we should be bold and aim to install as many as possible in the right locations. Will CDC commit itself to the target of installing at least one EVCP in all its main car parks by the end of 2017, including at least one at the Trinity Road offices for staff to use. By main car parks I would suggest any with at least 40 car parking spaces."
