Purpose of Report	To present Cabinet with a revised Council Tax, Housing Benefit and Council Tax Support Penalty and Prosecution Policy for approval and adoption.

## **Background Information**

- 1. The Counter Fraud Unit are undertaking a review of a number of Policies and Procedures, in support of each service area, to enable criminal investigations to be legally undertaken and appropriate sanctions to be applied. This Policy has been refreshed for use within Revenues and Housing Support Services.
- 2. The Policy replaces the Revenues and Housing Support Sanction Policy.
- 3. The legislation identifies that a Civil Penalty will only occur if the value of a Housing Benefit overpayment exceeds a minimum value; and the draft Policy for Cotswold District Council reflects this. The Policy also sets out the details relating to decisions at Cotswold District Council which can be amended in line with local decision-making.
- 4. The Policy was drafted on behalf of a number of Gloucestershire Authorities and West Oxfordshire District Council. Service Leads, Corporate Leadership/Management Teams and the Legal Section have been consulted
- 5. It should be recognised that the Counter Fraud Unit, and the service it provides, is a partnership, so co-ordinating policy across multiple organisations is critical to the success of the partnership.

6. The Cabinet is asked to consider the Council Tax, Housing Benefit and Council Tax Support Penalty and Prosecution Policy and, subject to any amendments that it considers necessary, to approve and adopt the same.
