BRIEFING NOTE

Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Council

(2) The nominations received in respect of these positions (Annual Council Meeting, Agenda Items (3) and (4)) are attached - **page 6**.

Strong Leader and Cabinet Governance Arrangements

- (3) The Council operates the Strong Leader and Cabinet form of governance. The Cabinet comprises the Leader of the Council, together with up to nine other Members to be appointed by the Leader (one of whom shall be appointed as Deputy Leader). The Leader is elected by the Council, for a four-year term.
- (4) At the Annual Council Meeting on 17th May 2011, Councillor Lynden Stowe was elected Leader of the Council, to serve for the four-year term of the Council (see Annual Council Meeting Agenda Item (7)).
- (5) The Leader's appointments to the Cabinet are attached **pages 7-9** (Annual Council Meeting Agenda Item (8) refers). Such appointments are purely for information/noting.

<u>Committee Memberships</u> (Annual Council Meeting Agenda Item (9))

(6) With the exception of the Cabinet, the Regulations in respect of political proportionality on Committees will apply (the 'Widdicombe Rules'). Any Councillor who is not a member of a Political Group will be entitled to serve on one Committee.

(7) Based on the number of Members across each group, and the five non-aligned Members, the following allocation of seats is suggested across those Committees that are subject to the 'Widdicombe Rules':-

- (8) It is for the political groups to make their own decisions regarding the allocation of Committee places to their members (within the overall allocation of seats); and the allocations made are attached pages 10-12.
- (9) The places to be allocated across the non-aligned Members have yet to be determined amongst those Members. The allocations made will be reported orally at the Meeting.
- (10) A Member of the Cabinet is <u>not able</u> also to serve on the Audit and Scrutiny Committee.
- (11) Notwithstanding (11) above, a Member of the Cabinet is able to serve on the Planning Committee and/or the Licensing Committee.
- (12) The Chairman of the Council is <u>not able</u> to serve on either the Cabinet or the Audit and Scrutiny Committee. The Vice-Chairman of the Council is <u>not able</u> to serve on the Cabinet.
- (13) Notwithstanding (13) above, the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Council are able to serve on the Planning Committee and/or the Licensing Committee. However, the Chairman of the Council cannot serve on any Committee of which the Vice-Chairman of the Council is a Member; and vice versa.

Chairmen Etc. Nominations and Chairmanship Etc. Restrictions

- (14) The Chairman of the Council, by virtue of office, is not eligible to hold office as a Chairman of a Committee during his/her term.
- (15) No Member of the Cabinet is entitled to hold the office of the Chairman or Vice-Chairman of a Committee.
- (16) No Member of the Council is entitled to hold the office of the Chairman of more than one Committee at any time.

- (17) No Member of the Council is entitled to hold the office of the Chairman of the Council or the Chairman of any Committee for a continuous period of more than three years. Nor is he/she eligible to be a Chairman or Vice-Chairman of any Committee within one year of ceasing to hold office as Chairman of any Committee.
- (18) There is no longer a requirement for a nominee for election/appointment as a Chairman or Vice-Chairman (of either the Council or of a Committee) or as Leader of the Council, to be present at the Meeting at which the election/appointment is to take place.
- (19) The previous requirement for a secret ballot to be held in respect of voting on Member appointments has been dispensed with (Council Meeting, 1st May 2012).
- (20) With the exception of the Planning Committee, all Committee Vice-Chairmen positions have been dispensed with (Council Meeting, 14th May 2013).
- (21) The nominations made in respect of the various Committee Chairmen and Vice-Chairmen positions are attached pages 13-15 (to be dealt with by each Committee in turn at the close of the Annual Council Meeting).
