## Annex A: Political proportionalities on committees 2023-24

Seats on committees are allocated based on the principles set out in the Local Government and Housing At 1989 (Section I5). The allocation of seats to political groups has been reviewed based on the political composition of the Council following elections held on 4
May 2023:
Liberal Democrat: 21
Conservative: 9
Green: 2
Independent (non-grouped): 2

3. Non-grouped Independent members to be offered the final two unallocated seats (Audit and Governance and Performance and Appointments).
