The parish council has some plans for installing equipment that may need foundations but are obviously extremely cautious about digging into possibly contaminated ground. At a recent public meeting there were several questions asked about this which the current Parish Council could not answer as none of them were serving at the time. The case officer's report also mentions the need for a long-term monitoring and maintenance scheme. The parish council is unaware of any ongoing monitoring and has not been given any instructions for maintenance.

Please include the cost of registration, travel, meals and accommodation.  Many of my residents tell me they consider this sort of event to be little more than a taxpayer-funded jolly, particularly in an era of virtual meetings. What tangible benefits do you believe sending a delegation to that conference has delivered for Cotswold residents?	Four elected members and the Chief Executive attended the LGA Conference in October 2024. The total cost was £4228, which includes conference registration, accommodation, travel and meals. The Local Government Association is our national membership body working on behalf of all its member councils. Their annual event covers the most important issues facing local government and is well attended by MPs, local politicians, chief executives and other industry leaders.  The conference provides insights into the important issues in local government from the keynote speakers.
