The evaluation has established that the site had been subject to modern ground-levelling and makeup and a medieval/post-medieval furrow and a later post-medieval drain were recorded. No archaeological features pre-dating medieval/post-medieval period were recorded within the site.</i>  <i>On the basis of the evaluation results, I therefore advise that no archaeological remains of interest are likely to be impacted by the proposals and no further archaeological mitigation is necessary in relation to this application.'</i>  <i>Rachel Foster - Archaeologist Gloucestershire County Council</i>
