FURTHER INFORMATION TO SUPPORT NEW PREMISES LICENCE APPLICATION C/21/00852/PRMA

After receiving the comments made by South Cerney Parish Council, we would like to put forward the following comments regarding our plans at the site for the Sub-Committee's information:

- The company has been running the Gateway Centre since 2011 and has in this time delivered a successful business offering a key amenity for tourists and adding value to the Cotswold Water Park
- 2. We have already been using the indoor Café Space for Limited Private Parties and have ensured all music past 11pm is pre arranged only and not open to the general public
- 3. We have held events in the car park during 2020/21 including outdoor cinema screenings and outdoor pop-up events and these have been covered by TEN's
- 4. All events in the outdoor area will finish by 23.00 hours
- 5. We would like in the future to host some supper clubs in the café space in the evenings with the aim to include the local community
- 6. We would like to be able to host limited events outside the café area which are family friendly examples being
 - Meet Santa winter wonderland
 - Quiz Evenings
 - Food and Drink Pop Ups
 - Occasional Outdoor Cinema Nights
 - And events which do not require licensing: Acoustic Music/Selected Sports Showing such as Wimbledon
- 7. We have secured an additional 50/60 car parking spaces as overflow parking in the De Vere hotel site, accessed and signposted from the existing Car Park. This will help with the concerns regarding parking, however we understand that this is not a matter that should be considered under the Licensing Act 2003
- 8. We have plans to improve the existing car park surface

To summarise we feel that the site and local community would benefit and we feel that there are not enough TENS available per annum to cover our business plans as the outdoor area is not currently covered by our Premises Licence. This licence will ensure that we can adhere to the licensing regulations.
