Paths and car parking ways formed from compacted using cubic limestone gravel

- Native shrub species:
 at 60-80 cm high with:

 Myrica cinerascens (A)

Grey or buff Material 800 mm x 800 mm paving slabs or similar approved

New hedgelines to be planted to screen Lanes 8 from site entrance. Two rows planted at 4 per square metre (see species list)
