

| 11 | 22/04303/FUL (Berry Bank Main Road Oddington Moreton-in- Marsh) | Closest residents to Amphitheatre concerned by noise pollution - sound on occasions intrusive - not able to have windows open Length of time performers take rehearsing and/or setting up equipment - surely sound levels can be correctly set in fairly short time (25 mins?) and any further rehearsing done at much lower volume. Whatever sound levels set in Amphitheatre, adjustments made to allow for topography of area and wind speed/direction. Sound levels should be taken at various points in Oddington and along relevant parts of A436. Agree with Parish Council stand on this matter. If committee minded to approve applications, Parish Council put forward strict conditions to be placed on operation eg: 79db at perimeter and point source speakers. Noise Management Plan needs to reflect this and remove 110db maximum at front of house Whilst proprietor keen to find solution, if these conditions cannot be incorporated in any planning consent then would object to the application If committee approves application hope comments/concerns taken into consideration and incorporated in conditions made to operation of site |
