Notice of Intention Tree Preservation Order Re

TPO No 23/00003/IND

Swan House, Ditch Lane, Winson, GL75ER

I am writing to you in reference to our application to carry out a tree removal submitted on 26 May 2023, application no 23/01406/TCONR to request the removal of the Yew tree located at the rear of the property marked T1.

We are disappointed to hear that on your site visit to assess the tree, in your opinion the tree is worthy of a Tree Preservation Order to refuse the removal of the tree.

We would like to submit our findings to object to your decision in the hope that you will approve our original application.

The main reason for the removal of the Yew tree, the Yew is in close proximity of the building and concerns that the location is undermining the outbuilding.

Swan House has undergone major conservation work at the back of the property and the Yew is within 4 metres of this work carried out. The concerns are any damage to further conservation work in the future as the house is a listed building.




